Directions to 9 Walker Street

From Route 495, take exit 18 east (Route 126 Bellingham)
Continue on Route 126 1.5 mi.
Turn right onto Village Street 2.8 mi.
Turn right onto Walker Street, bear right at fork .2 mi.

From Route 128, take exit 16B, (Route 109 Westwood)
Continue on Route 109 to through Medfield Center 7.0 mi.
Remain on Route 109 to left turn for Village St. 2.0 mi.
(Millis sign on center island)
Continue on Village Street (bear right at fork) 3.8 mi.
Turn left onto Walker Street, bear right at fork .2 mi.
